

WHAT CAN I DO IF I AM NOT MARRIED TO MY ABUSER?

Unmarried children under the age of 21 who are abused by their United States citizen or LPR parent are eligible for VAWA. Parents of abused children are also eligible for VAWA.

DO I NEED TO SEE AN IMMIGRATION ATTORNEY?

Do not go to the INS without first speaking to a lawyer. If you cannot afford a lawyer, contact a domestic violence shelter, legal services organization or Nā Loio to locate attorneys who may be able to help you at low cost or for free.
